### Mission Philippines ~ Children's Needs

Corinth is seeking new and/or gently used children's summer clothing and shoes to be shipped to the children living in a cemetery and dump site in the Philippines. We are asking for clean clothes and shoes to fit children 12 years and under. They can be dropped off at the church or given to Earl Brinkley at the Transportation Store in Wallace. Needed items are:

- Feeding Money
- Tents for Kids
- Caution Vests (we are using brightly colored backpacks)
- Medical Supplies as follows:
  - Over the Counter Pain Relievers-Individually Wrapped
  - OTC Allergy Pills (Benadryl) Individually Wrapped
  - Antibiotic Cream
  - Band-Aids/Gauze/Tape
  - Antiseptic Wipes (to clean wounds)
  - Alcohol Wipes
  - Anti-itch Cream/Mosquito Bite Cream
  - Other types of Wipes
  - Blood Pressure Tester
- Clothing: shorts, underwear, t-shirts (no jackets or sweaters)
- Shoes: flip-flops, tennis shoes, water shoes, socks
- Hygiene Items:
  - toothbrushes, toothpaste, fluoride rinse/tablets
  - shampoo
  - soap
  - lotion
  - combs, brushes
  - laundry power or bars
  - ladies feminine products
